## **ORDINANCE 07-2010**

## ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING POSITION OF DEPUTY TAX ASSESSOR

WHEREAS, by Ordinance the Borough has in place the position of Tax Assessor, and N.J.S.A. 40A:9-146 authorizes the Borough to establish the position of Deputy Tax Assessor as determined necessary or appropriate by the Borough, and

WHEREAS, it has been recommended by the Borough Administrator that the position of Deputy Tax Assessor be established, to provide for such qualified person to assist and/or substitute for the Tax Assessor in the event of unavailability, and

WHEREAS, the Borough Governing Body has determined that it is appropriate under the circumstances to establish that position.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Atlantic Highlands that the position of Deputy Tax Assessor is hereby established and authorized, to perform the duties and functions as per N.J.S.A. 40A:9-148.1; the term of said Deputy Tax Assessor as per N.J.S.A. 40A:9-148 shall be 4 years, commencing July 1, 2010.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the compensation for the position of Deputy Tax Assessor, for services rendered, shall be fixed by Resolution appointing the named individual to the position of Deputy Tax Assessor, and shall be at a rate between \$25.00 and \$50.00 per hour, plus reimbursement of out of pocket expenses, upon submission of vouchers to be approved by the Borough Administrator.
