

NOTICE OF PENDING BOND ORDINANCE

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, was introduced and passed upon first reading at a meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Atlantic Highlands, New Jersey, held on June 13, 2012. It will be further considered for final passage, after public hearing thereon, at a meeting of the governing body to be held at the Municipal Building, 100 First Avenue, in Atlantic Highlands, New Jersey on June 27, 2012 at 7:00 o'clock P.M. During the week prior to and up to and including the date of such meeting copies of the full ordinance will be available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for the members of the general public who shall request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

- Title: Bond Ordinance Re-appropriating \$66,657.20 Proceeds of Obligations Not Needed For Their Original Purposes and To Be Used For Various Harbor Improvements by The Borough Of Atlantic Highlands County Of Monmouth, New Jersey
- Purpose(s): Re-appropriation of funds from Bond Ordinance 18-2007 for the following purpose: various harbor improvements, including but not limited to paving, concrete and other general harbor improvements.

Appropriation: \$66,657.20

Bonds/Notes Authorized: \$66,657.20 Grants (if any) Appropriated: None Section 20 Costs: \$10,000

Useful Life: 40 years
