ORDINANCE 06-2013

APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF \$1,500,000 FOR HARBOR IMPROVEMENTS FOR AND BY THE BOROUGH OF ATLANTIC HIGHLANDS IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY AND, ANTICIPATING A RECEIVABLE FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,500,000 TO FINANCE THE APPROPRIATION

WHEREAS, the Borough has received notification from the Federal Emergency Management Agency of funding for Harbor Improvements related to Superstorm Sandy; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated Funding is in excess of \$1,500,000; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed appropriate to make use of the \$1,500,000 for the following Capital Project: \$1,500,000 – Various Harbor Improvements, including removal of the pilings and other portions of harbor damaged by Superstorm Sandy and the reconstruction of the harbor, including all work or materials necessary therefore or incidental thereto.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Borough of Atlantic Highlands, County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, that;

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated from the Receivable due from the Federal Emergency Management Agency for Superstorm Sandy, the sum of \$1,500,000 for Various Harbor Improvements as detailed above.

SECTION 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent with the terms of this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of their inconsistency.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon proper passage and publication in accordance with law.
