MINUTES-MARCH 22, 2018 REGULAR MEETING BOROUGH HALL, 6:30PM

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

PROGRAMS/EVENTS:

Committee members will meet at Firemen's Field at 12PM to set up. 3000 eggs were filled by the organization Sunny Bunny. There will be three different age groups ranging from 1-3, 4-6 and 7-10. Each age group will have a chance to win 1 of 4 baskets per group. The Easter Bunny will also be there for the children. Determination on a shot gun start or each age group going separately, will be decided Saturday morning. Jacqui suggested that maybe next year they could have a candy bingo for the older kids or a glow in the dark Easter Egg Hunt. She will look into the possibility of using the Atlantic Highlands Elementary School grounds for this.

Summer Recreation- Both Laura and Ryan will be returning to run this year's Summer Recreation Program. Counselor applications will be accepted from May 1-May 31, 2018. It was unanimously approved, by the Recreation committee members in attendance, that the Finger printing fees for those counselors 18 and over would be reimbursed back to them.
