The CDBG Disaster Recovery program includes a number of initiatives to assist people and communities impacted by Superstorm Sandy. The State anticipates helping 18,000 homeowners, 6,300 renters, 10,000 businesses, and dozens of local governmental entities.

DCA Landlord Incentive Program

The New Jersey Department of Community Affairs (DCA) has launched the Landlord Incentive Program (LIP), which provides project-based incentive payments to apartment owners who, in turn, must execute a LIP agreement to keep rents affordable to low- and moderate-income households for a two-year term in communities hard-hit by Superstorm Sandy.

Existing vacant market-rate units including rental housing where the property owner has full site control are considered eligible properties. Units that are currently occupied, but will be vacant within the next 90 days are also eligible.
