Contact your **child's school** if they receive free or reduced cost lunch. Each school is disbursing lunch/food through different processes.

New Jersey has an online application and screening tool, [NJHelps](#), that can be used to see if you are eligible for food assistance (SNAP) or cash assistance (WFNJ/TANF or WFNJ/GA).

Lunch Break has been given an emergency fund to assist those impacted by the COVID-19 virus. Call 732.385.3971

SNAP: During the current public health crisis, your case will not be closed if you are unable to participate in a work activity. If your case is due to be recertified in March, April or May and you are unable to get your paperwork in or complete your interview, your case will not be closed. You will receive your benefits on the usual day. Your case has been granted a six-month extension from the date your recertification is due. More information will follow on your new recertification date. In the meantime, you will continue to receive SNAP benefits.
